




Micro-planning for slum infrastructure

VOICES



"I had the hunger to grow and succeed in life. My husband was also working as a daily wage earner and I dreamt of a better life. From being a member of an SHG to forming SHGs – I can do anything in life!" A housemaid till 5 years ago; joined an SHG & was motivated to become a Mobilizer earning Rs. 200 for every group formed – went on to form 22 groups. Today drives an e-rickshaw purchased through a bank loan – 10 other women are motivated to do the same

Underwent skill training under Lijjat Papad and motivated 10 SHGs in her slum to engage in this livelihood




"Had I not been a member of the SHG, it would have been difficult for me to encourage other women in my slum to work on their own. Today, women from many households are engaged in work and no one sits idle. It has ensured better standards of living and a happy family."

Facilitated construction of 132 toilets in her slum

"I had hardly been out of my locality for years. It is because of Samvardhan project that I got my own identity and today I even fight with the officials of the Nagar Parishad to see that works for women get completed on priority."

"I realised that the loans from the SHG savings could be utilised effectively and that a sewing machine can help increase my earnings."

A 'reluctant' SHG member, today she is building a tailoring business on the back of SHG loans – has tied up with a large saree showroom in town and earns between Rs. 5000-6000 per month
